

Guidelines

Fuller Lake Arena is gradually reopening under the COVID-19 Safety Plan, based on information and advice from health authorities, other levels of government, WorkSafeBC, the BCRPA, VIASport and Provincial and National sport governing bodies.

- The only entrance to the arena is through the main upstairs doors.
- A COVID-19 screening will occur prior to entry. Use of the facility is prohibited to people showing signs of illness.
- Masks are mandatory in all common public indoor spaces - exceptions include children under 2 years of age, or persons with underlying medical conditions or disability which inhibits their ability to wear a face covering.
- Arrive no more than 10 minutes prior to the start of your program, and leave the facility as quickly as possible following your session, staying no longer than 10 minutes.
- Hand sanitizer is provided in the lobby for people to use when entering and exiting the facility; however, handwashing is the preferred method.
- Follow directional signage throughout the facility.
- Patrons must exit the facility through the lower doors marked "Exit".
- If you require interaction with staff, please ensure you maintain physical distance of no less than 2 metres (6 feet).
- Bleachers are closed, and spectators are not permitted at this time.
- Spitting is not permitted in the building, if caught you will be asked to leave immediately.
- If entering the facility, it is expected that you are attending a program or activity, or completing a transaction at reception. All other persons are asked to remain outside the facility in order to lower occupancy and maintain physical distancing.
