

Project Objectives

Water management is the first priority of the Agricultural Advisory Committee (AAC), in particular access to water, drainage, control, water use efficiency and water quality.

A number of different approaches and solutions for agricultural water management have been tried with limited success.

The project objectives are to:

- Establish finer-grained planning and engineering management policies for land-use and infrastructure to guide future physical development in the area.**
- Identify strategies to control runoff from existing highways, roads, rail and other built development within the watershed.**
- Review water management strategies available to the Municipality.**
- Review of applicable legislation and the preparation of bylaws and policies for water management in support of agriculture.**
- Ensure that the plan embodies the vision of the stakeholders.**
- Identify existing and future water needs for agriculture, fish and other uses.**
- Prepare an agriculture water reserve recommendation.**
- Develop an implementation plan.**
