Please check one of the following boxes:
☐ The Retaining Wall is considered Critical to the Stability of a Building Foundation
 If the retaining wall is critical to the stability of a building foundation and is within the zone of influence (as explained in the "Professional Practice Guidelines Retaining Wall Design"), Letters of Assurance in the form of a Schedule B are required.
☐ The Retaining Wall is not considered Critical to the Stability of a Building Foundation
 If the retaining wall does not meet the zone of influence requirements (as explained in the "Professional Practice Guidelines Retaining Wall Design"), a "Retaining Wall Assurance Statement" (as outlined in the "Professional Practice Guidelines Retaining Wall Design) is required prior to final approval.
For retaining walls over 1.2 meters in height (see Retaining Wall Handbook)
Retaining Walls over 2 Meters in height require a Development Permit with Variance – Please contact the Planning Department for further information.

☐ Agent Authorization Form (Required if property owner is not applying for permit)
□ Title Search (Copy of title printed within 30 days of application date - include all related rights-of-way, easements an covenants. Obtained from the Land Title Office or a lawyer, notary or real estate office.)
□ Covenants, Easements and Rights-of-Way (Obtained from the Land Title Office or a lawyer, notary or real estate office Document numbers are listed on Title Search)
☐ Site Plan of Subject Property to Scale (Include the proposed and required setbacks, existing building location, location of proposed retaining wall, and driveway location)
□ Required Drawings
One set of Sealed Engineered plans ($minimum\ scale\ 3/16''=1'\ for\ floor\ plan\ and\ 1/8''-1'\ for\ elevations$)
☐ Foundation Plan ☐ Cross Section
☐ Site Disclosure Statement (Required by Ministry of Environment)
☐ Business Licence (if applicable)
This checklist is intended to provide you with the minimum requirements for a Retaining Wall Permit application pursuant to the
