


2024 Fourth Quarter Report North Cowichan Fire Department

February 5, 2025 Regular Council Meeting

Administration: Structure and Leadership

- Business planning has taken place in preparation for the 2025 Budget process.
- Council and Fire Services Appreciation & Awards banquet was held in November.
- Crofton Fire Station has been completed, firefighters have moved into the new section, with "Opening Ceremony" for the public early in May.
- New recruitment drive was completed with 26 applications with 16 new recruit firefighters and 3 junior firefighters for South End, Chemainus, Crofton and Maple Bay fire stations. The recruitment process included individuals participating in fitness testing, written exams and interviews with Chiefs and Human Resources staff. New recruits are to start in early 2025.
- District of North Cowichan Fire Underwriters Survey (FUS) was received. Staff is reviewing the FUS
 report and will be delivering the outcomes to Council in the early part of 2025. FUS provides the
 fire insurance grade for insurance rates.
- New fire apparatus to arrive in Q1 2025, with delivery sooner than anticipated.





2024 Quarter 4 Incident Calls by Station






2024 Quarter 4 Training
