Amendment to Business Licence Bylaw

NOTICE IS GIVEN that Council for the District of North Cowichan will be considering amendments to Business Licence Bylaw No. 3153, 2002, as amended, through the adoption of Business Licence Amendment Bylaw No. 4058 at their Regular meeting being held on Wednesday, February 18, 2026, at 5:00 p.m.. The amendment, in general, proposes to include consideration for neighbours, good neighbour agreements, and licence suspension and cancellation provisions.

Anyone who considers themselves to be affected by the bylaw will be provided an opportunity to make representation to Council during the meeting, or they may submit their written comments by:
